




## School Of Health, Education, Policing & Sciences

## UNIFORM FAQs

### How do I order my uniform?

During Welcome Week you will receive login details for the uniform supplier's website where you will be able to select the items and sizes that you require.

### What size uniform will I need?

It is important that your uniform fits comfortably, allowing freedom of movement to undertake the various activities required in your role. If you are unsure what size to order use the online sizing guide on the uniform provider's website.

### When will I receive my uniform?

We will inform you of the expected hand out date when you start your course. This date will be before your first clinical practice placement.

### Where will I collect my uniform from?

Uniforms will be handed out on campus. Details of the collection date and times will be emailed to your student email address after you start your course and place your order.

### What happens if my uniform does not fit?

When collecting your uniform you will need to try on **ONE** of each item. Any items which do not fit **MUST** be handed back and an exchange requested. Please note there will be a deadline for any exchanges.

If your uniform does not fit after the deadline or later in your course you will need to purchase uniform items yourself. Simply contact [PLH@staffs.ac.uk](mailto:PLH@staffs.ac.uk) to request a student account to be created for you with our uniform supplier. You can then purchase any additional items and arrange delivery direct to your term-time accommodation.

### When will I be expected to wear my uniform?

During any on campus practical skills sessions, and when out on clinical practice placements (except for Operating Department Practice students).

Operating Department Students will only wear their University scrubs on campus in practical skills sessions; their placement provider will supply scrubs for placement.

### What if I am pregnant during my course?

Maternity uniform is provided free of charge. Email [PLH@staffs.ac.uk](mailto:PLH@staffs.ac.uk) to advise of your pregnancy, and to confirm the items and sizes required. Please be mindful that maternity uniform may take 8-12 weeks to be delivered to the University by the supplier so you must contact us as early as possible.

### Can I purchase extra items of uniform?

You may purchase additional items or different sizes of uniform yourself. Simply email [PLH@staffs.ac.uk](mailto:PLH@staffs.ac.uk) to request a student account to be created for you with our uniform supplier. Once you receive the login details for the uniform supplier's website you can purchase any additional items and arrange delivery direct to your term-time accommodation.
